- → Performers can do multiple shows in one day to accommodate larger audiences.
 Discounts may apply for additional performance on the same day at the same location.
 (Performance must start within 2 hours of the first performance.)
- → Shows should be booked a minimum of two weeks in advance; more time is required for a specific date or show.
- → Immersion workshops are available to extend the performance experience into the classroom.
